# HOW TO BOOK

**Event entry form** – simply add the number of people camping in your group within the online entry form.

If you have already entered the event, you can edit your race entry details to include the camping.

Follow the EDIT YOUR ENTRY button found within your race entry confirmation email. If you can't find your confirmation email, contact [andy@racinglinerunning.co.uk](mailto:andy@racinglinerunning.co.uk) and it will be resent

Payment for the camping will taken at this point.

**Via email** – email [andy@racinglinerunning.co.uk](mailto:andy@racinglinerunning.co.uk) by April 16<sup>th</sup> and tell us how many people will be camping in your group.

Payment will then need to be made on race day at Race Registration.

**CAMPING MUST BE BOOKED IN ADVANCE.**

# GETTING TO THE EVENT & CAMPING

Camping at Dummer Down Farm is available for the night of Saturday April 17<sup>th</sup> only. The official camping season at the venue doesn't start until May 1<sup>st</sup>.

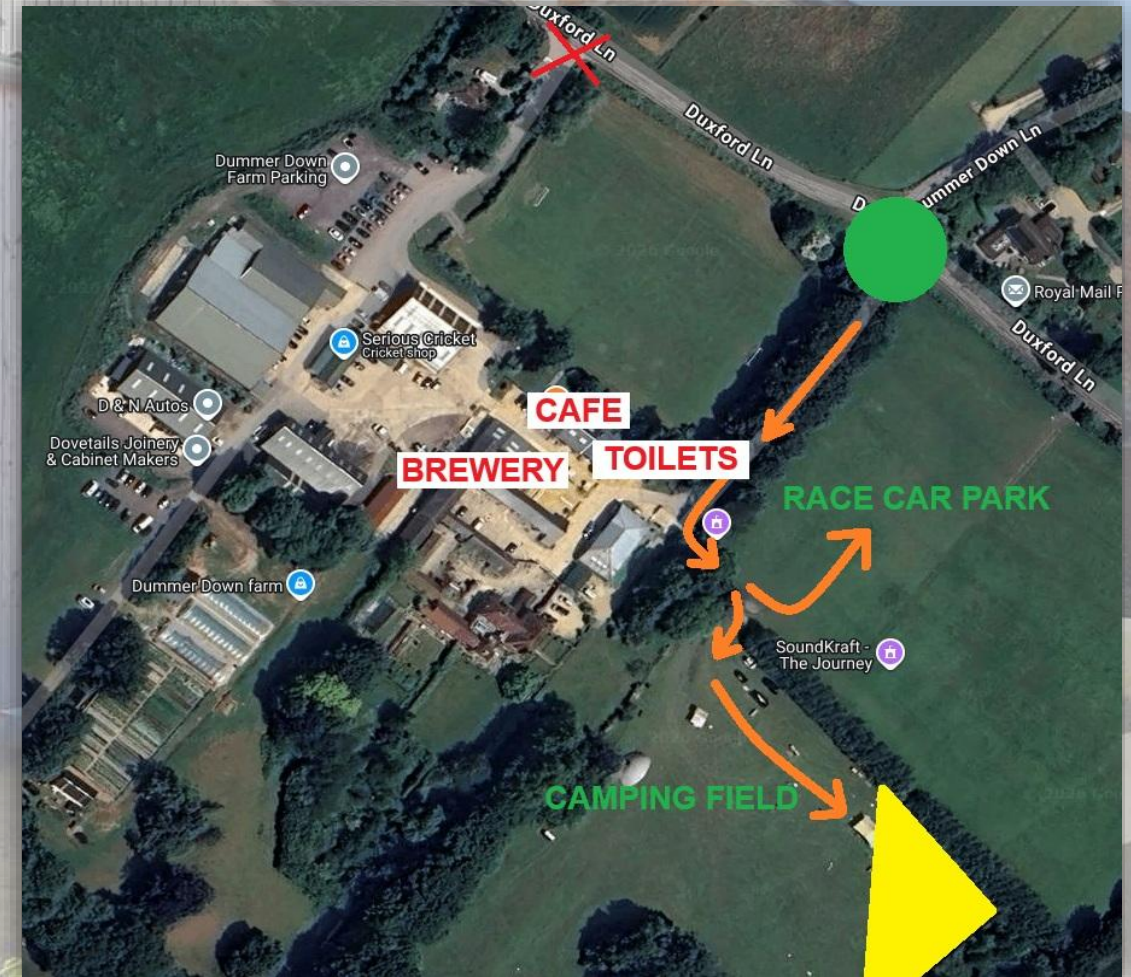
You'll have access to the camping field from 16:00 until after your run on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup>.

There is no camping access via the entrance signed for the Cricket Centre or Honesty Café.

At the end of the driveway you'll pick up our Campsite signage. Turn left, then right into the camping field.

Find a space in the left-hand corner to reduce noise for the nearby farmhouse. There are no marked camping bays.



# INFO, FACILITIES & FAQs

**Cost** - Camping is £10 per person, adults & children.

**Arrival/Check In** – you can arrive from **16:00** on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup>. There is no check in required; simply find yourself a spot in the camping field and make yourself at home. Please settle in the far left corner of the field, farthest away from the farmhouse.

**Tents/Vans?** - you can camp in either tents or vans

**Timings** – the brewery is open from 16:00 – 22:00 on Saturday. The Honesty Café is open from 08:00 on Sunday morning. Event registration on Sunday opens from 08:15.

**Facilities** - there are portable toilets available, along with 'proper' toilets and wash basins available in the brewery building during their opening hours. The café also has toilets whilst it is open.

The brewery has a food vendor on the Saturday evening, and breakfast in the café is available from 08:00 on Sunday.

Camping is on grass, and there is no shower block at this time of year.

**General Info** - you're allowed to camp with dogs. You can use your own cooking facilities.

The camping area is next door to the event car park (runners will start arriving from 08:00 on Sunday) and about 100m from the brewery/cafe/toilets.
